Parking Lot

We know that parking is at a premium in the morning and at the end of the day. Please make sure you are not parking in the through lanes, bus lanes, or in no parking areas. Our drop-off area is just outside the library. If that is full, please park in the parking lot to avoid unsafe situations and blocking off traffic. Please use the crosswalk and crossing guard when moving back and forth between the parking lot and the school.

Drop Off


Supervision for students begins at 7:30 a.m. Please do not drop off your students or have them walk to school before supervision begins. We also ask that if you are using the drop-off lane, that you remain in your car. This will keep traffic flowing. If you need to get out of your car, please park in the parking lot.

End of Day Pick Up

We are doing our best at the end of the day to ensure that students get to their busses on time, or for those that are picked up by a parent, that this happens safely. To reduce congestion, we ask that students and parents do not congregate at the front entrance so students can get to their bus or car without walking through a crowd. Students who are getting picked up by a car are asked to wait on the sidewalk in front of the Library. We also ask that students who are walking, biking, or scootering home, to leave the campus right away. Those waiting for late buses are asked to wait on the playground and to avoid the front entranceway.

Just a reminder to order your school yearbook early. The cost of the Yearbook is currently **\$45.00** if you order from the school office and pay before December 31st. The price of the yearbook will increase to \$50.00 after December 31st.

Medical Alert

If your child has a medical condition or allergy that may be life-threatening, or requires your son or daughter to use an Epipen or Inhaler, please notify our office staff so that we are able to update our files with their correct information. Please provide the office staff with an up-to-date Epipen or Asthma Inhaler that can be kept on hand should your child require its use while they are at school. Students who use prescription medication at school are required to have a Medical Alert Form completed and kept on file at the school office.

Permission Click Forms

You may have already received this form through Permission Click.... if not then early next week you will receive an email to complete the School District #33 Technology Acceptable Use Agreement form through *Permission Click*. It is important for all of our students to have this form completed in order for them to:

- Log-in to a school computer
- Use Student Wi-Fi
- Access any online services such as Office 365

Next week, we will also be sending out through Permission Click, the Media Parent Release form. These forms are required to be completed for all students yearly.

Star Reader Program



The Star Reader program is once again happening at Rosedale. All elementary students are invited to participate in the 150 nights of reading sponsored by the Chilliwack Kiwanis Club.

If your child reads for 15 minutes a night, or you to them, record it in their "Reading Log" which is located in their Agenda Book. For the Primary Classes that do not use agenda books, students can pick up a "Reading Log" from the Library. Once they have completed 25 nights, return the log to the Library and they will be eligible for some great prizes. There will be special presentations upon reaching 100 nights. 
RTCS Multicultural Awareness Calendar

KIDSPORT PAYS So ALL Kids Can Play!

The KidSport program aims to remove financial barriers to sport participation by providing grants to help cover the cost of sport registration fees So *ALL* Kids Can Play!

ABOUT KIDSPORT GRANTS

- Children 18 and younger could be eligible for funding to help cover the cost of their sport registration. The average grant max is \$400 per child per calendar year*.
- Sport activities must be affiliated with the member sport organizations of Sport BC (like BC School Sports), demonstrate a sustained sport experience (a season of sport led by a qualified coach) for a minimum of 6 weeks, and include at least one session per week
- If approved**, the grant is paid directly to the school to help cover the registration fee for the sport activity

^{*} Grant amount is determined by each community chapter and ranges from \$300 - \$800, depending on the chapter's funding capacity. Most chapters grant \$300 - \$400.

WE WORK TO ENSURE THAT NO KID IS EVER LEFT WATCHING FROM THE SIDELINES

There are 40 community chapters across BC that each fundraise, accept applications and distribute grants to support kids in their local community. For communities that don't have a chapter, grant requests are supported through our Provincial Fund.

HOW TO APPLY

- Register in an eligible sport program
- Apply online at kidsportcanada.ca or download a paper application. Applicants need to submit their Notice of Assessment from the most recent tax year that shows line 15000, OR have an endorser* sign their application to verify the social and economic barriers of the family.
- Submit the completed application to your local chapter or KidSport BC. Completed paper applications can be emailed to kidsport@sportbc.com, mailed to KidSport BC 250-999 Canada Place Vancouver BC V6C 3C1 or faxed to 604.333.3401

Last year KidSport chapters distributed \$1.7M to fund a season of sport for 5,377 kids in 180 communities across BC, including 240 kids totaling over \$62,000 for school sports.
