Field Trip Consent Forms

All student field trip consent / permission forms, (for all Grades K-8), are now required to be completed electronically – this applies to all field trips with or without a cost to them. Parents simply need to login to their student quick pay account and locate the form under the Field Trip heading. Once you select the field trip form to be completed, fill out the required information, then click the submit button. If there is a cost for the field trip, the charge will automatically be added to your child's account to be paid. <u>Note</u>: All fields on the consent/permission form must be fully completed or the form will not be submitted.

GRANT APPLICATION GUIDELINES KidSport BC Provincial Fund

KidSport provides funding for kids from families that need financial support to help cover the cost of sport registration fees #SoALLKidsCanPlay! KidSport BC's Provincial Fund supports kids from communities that don't have a KidSport chapter. Max grant: up to \$400 per child per calendar year.

HOW TO APPLY

REGISTER YOUR CHILD IN A SPORT

- Sport must be affiliated with the member sport organizations of Sport BC (see sportbc.com/members)
- Programs should be a min. of 6 weeks with at least one session per week
- Applications can be submitted online or using our paper form, ideally prior to the start of the sport program
- Online applications require your Notice of Assessment showing line 15000 from the most recent tax year* for all income earners in the household, OR
- If you're applying using the paper form you must submit <u>one</u> of:
 - Your most recent Notice of Assessment for all income earners in the household
 - Proof of foster parent status, income assistance or disability assistance
 - <u>OR</u> have a trusted professional endorse your application to verify your financial need
- Completed paper applications can be submitted by email, mail or fax.
- IF APPROVED, FUNDS ARE SENT TO THE SPORT CLUB
- Please allow up to 60 days for notification of application status
- The KidSport chapter must be notified if the athlete withdraws from the sport activity

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Kids years old 18 and younger
- Facing financial hardships*
- Registered in an eligible sport program
- Camps, equipment, dance, travel, fundraising, and championships <u>do not qualify</u>

*KidSport considers social and economic barriers facing the athlete's family when determining eligibility for funding. Statistics Canada's Low Income Guidelines (LICO) are used <u>as a guideline</u> to determine financial eligibility. If your income is higher, extenuating circumstances can also be taken into account.
