Cowboy Poetry Gathering


Every January thousands of cowboys and their families gather around to share and listen to poetry in Elko, Nevada. This special roundup is called the annual Cowboy Poetry Gathering. It's where cowboy poets, musicians, and actors show off their creative sides. The very first festival was held in 1985. About 40 poets gathered and shared poems with an audience of nearly 1,000 spectators. Today, the event has grown into a much larger gathering.

The Cowboy Poetry Gathering has been described as the most honest and open-hearted festival in America. It's where rough and tough cowboys share poems in a variety of styles and topics. Some poems are about the solitude of their work, animals, nature, or even the code of the West. Other poems address larger issues like violence or human rights.

While poetry is a large part of the gathering, there are a variety of other events. Attendees can participate in dancing, workshops and there's plenty of music to enjoy.

This modern celebration of poetry and the cowboy life honors traditions that date back to the 1870s. In the past cowboys wrote poems to express their values and recognize their experiences while herding cattle along the trails of the West. Today, cowboys share some of the same experiences in a brand new way.
